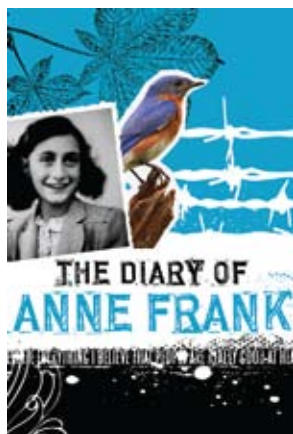
A Holiday Spectacle
